

Ramadan Du'as (Supplications)

Du'a of Iftar (Breaking fast)

اللَّهُمَّ إِنِّي لَكَ صُمْتُ وَبِكَ آمَنْتُ وَعَلَيْكَ تَوَكَّلْتُ وَعَلَى رِزْقِكَ أَفْطَرْتُ
ذَهَبَ الظَّمَأُ وَابْتَلَّتِ العُرُوقُ وَثَبَتَ الأَجْرُ إِن شَاءَ اللهُ

**Allahumma inni laka sumtu, wa bika aamantu, wa 'alayka
tawakkaltu, wa 'ala rizqika aftartu.**

Dhuhabaz zama'u wab tallatil 'uroqu, wa thabat al ajru inshaAllah.

O Allah! I fasted for You and I believe in You, and I put my trust in You, and I break my fast with Your sustenance. "The thirst is gone, the veins are moistened and the reward is confirmed, if Allah (AJ) Wills." [Abu Dawud 2:306]

Du'a of Suhoor (Intention to fast)

وَبِصَوْمٍ غَدٍ نَّوَيْتُ مِنْ شَهْرِ رَمَضَانَ

Wa bi sawmi ghadin nawaytu min shahri Ramadan.

I intend to keep the fast for tomorrow in the month of Ramadan [Abu Dawud]

Tarawih's Prayer and Supplication

Salatul Tarawih (nightly devotion) is prayed at time of Salatul `Isha (night time prayer) as follows:

1. **Salatul `Isha** -
Pray 2-4 Rak'ats (cycles) Sunnah,
4 Rak'ats Fard and 2-4 Rak'ats Sunnah of `Isha.
2. **Intention of Fasting:** Make intention to fast the obligatory fast of Ramadan the next day, then intend to pray Salatul Tarawih (20 Rak'ats)
3. **Salatul Tarawih** (20 Rak'ats)
After each four rak'ats of salatul Tarawih, sit and read

- **3x Suratul Ikhlas** (Chapter 112 of Holy Quran)
- **1x** Recite the following **Tarawih Du'a** (Supplication)

لِقَاءِ اللَّهِ يُرْجَى فِي الصِّيَامِ، وَنُورُ الْقَلْبِ فِي الْقِيَامِ، تَعَالَى اللَّهُ ذُو الْعَرْشِ الْمَجِيدُ،
الصَّلَاةُ الْجَامِعَةُ صَلَاةُ التَّرَاوِيحِ أَثَابَكُمْ اللَّهُ، النَّبِيُّ يَشْفَعُ لِمَنْ يُصَلِّي عَلَيْهِ.
اللَّهُمَّ صَلِّ عَلَى سَيِّدِنَا مُحَمَّدٍ، وَعَلَى آلِ سَيِّدِنَا مُحَمَّدٍ. اللَّهُمَّ إِنَّا نَسْأَلُكَ الْجَنَّةَ وَنَعُوذُ بِكَ مِنَ النَّارِ.

Liqā ullāhi yurjā fis Siyam, Wa Noorul Qalbi fil qiyaam, Ta'alAllahu dhul 'Arshil Majid. As Salatul jami'a salatut Tarawih, athaba kumullah. An Nabi yashfa'o liman yusalli 'alayh. Allahumma Sali 'ala Sayyidina Muhammad, wa a'la aali Sayyidina Muhammad. Allahumma innaa nas'alukal jannata, wa na'odhubika minan Naar.

There will be a meeting and proximity with the divine presence during fasting, and the heart will be illuminated during the nightly prayer of devotion. Allah Almighty owns the glorious throne. May Allah (AJ) reward the people who gather and pray Tarawih Prayers. The prophet (pbuh) is interceding for the ones who send praising and salutation upon him. O Allah send peace and blessings upon our prophet Muhammad (pbuh) and his blessed family. O Allah, we seek your paradise and we seek refuge in you from hellfire.
